To celebrate the 100th year of E. Mounier's birth, an international convention has been carried out by Centro Ricerche Personaliste and the Silesian University. Students of this thinker, considered to be the father of the personalism, convened in Rome from several parts of the world, including Africa and South America. Two volumes have been collected of the most important contents of the debate between experts: Mounier's life, concepts of person, communities, dialogue, equality and difference in the relationship of man and woman, ecumenism, the role of intellectuals, and education. The two books also collect interesting comparisons between representatives of personalism in various linguistic areas and various perspectives and guidelines. Furthermore, it is possible to find in the books essays that face challenges of contemporary society and culture, such as new technologies, problems of bioethics, new communicative competences, and globalization. It makes itself see if and in which measure a new formulation of the concept of person and development are acceptable for XXI the century. The model of dominant development present rather obvious limits, after the landslide of real Socialism and the crisis of liberalism. The concept of person seems to be a starting point, where different ideologies and religions can find their encounters.
